EEC delegation in town

A trade delegation of the European Economic Community arrived in Kuwait on Sunday night. The 22-member team visited the Kuwait Chamber of Commerce and Industry yesterday for talks with officials on means to bolster cooperation. Chamber sources said the 17man delegation discussed avenues of cooperation between Kuwait and the EEC in commercial fields.

The delegation, which groups members from seven European states, is headed by Angelos Pangratis. It will leave Kuwait, the final stop of its tour of GCC states, tomorrow.

The undersecretary of finance and industry is scheduled to meet the delegation members today.
